Burn Out: Save Yourself and Your Staff

Compassion Fatigue refers to the intense emotional and physical destruction that takes place when helpers are unable to refuel and regenerate their own capability for self-compassion. You cannot care for others if you do not take care of yourself. Self-care is important to enable you to be an effective educator or administrator and allows you to model good balance and healthy boundaries.

This workshop focuses on self-care: participants will measure current levels of compassion fatigue, identify unmet needs, reflect, and adopt self-care strategies.

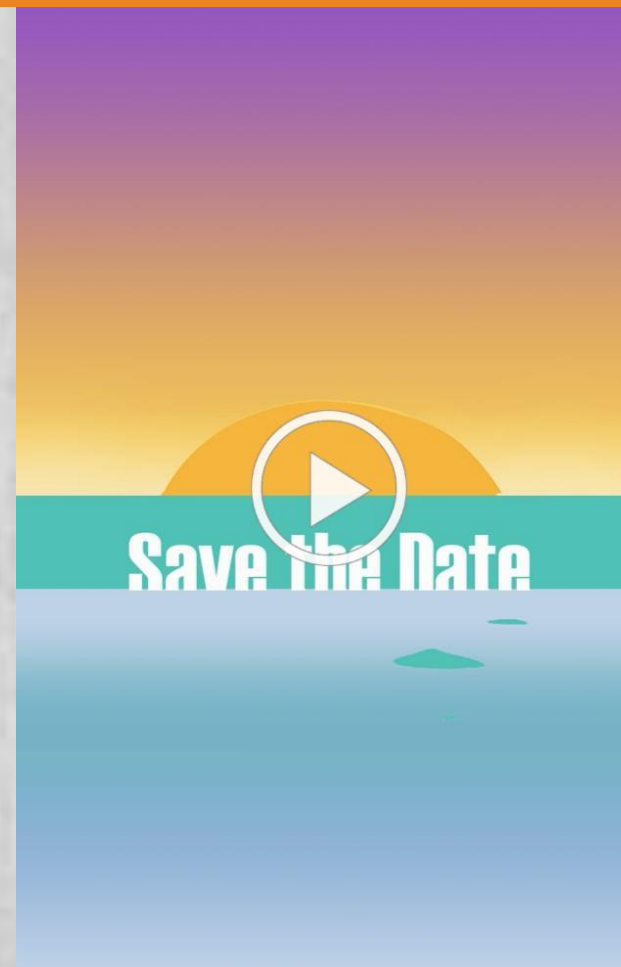
