



### Housing Services | Emergency Housing Vouchers (EHV)

- 51 move-ins
- 145 vouchers available through Sept. 2023

### Eligible to apply if:

- 57+ years old
- <24 with a minor child</li>
- fleeing domestic violence
- chronically unsheltered (5-7 years on street)
- in a housing program and waiting for permanent supportive housing




