The availability of adequate housing without discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, handicap, familial status or marital status is a matter of concern to the people of Jacksonville and more particularly of concern to the City in providing for the health, welfare, safety and morals of the people of Jacksonville.”

DEFINITIONS

Category 4: Fleeing/Attempting to Flee Domestic Violence

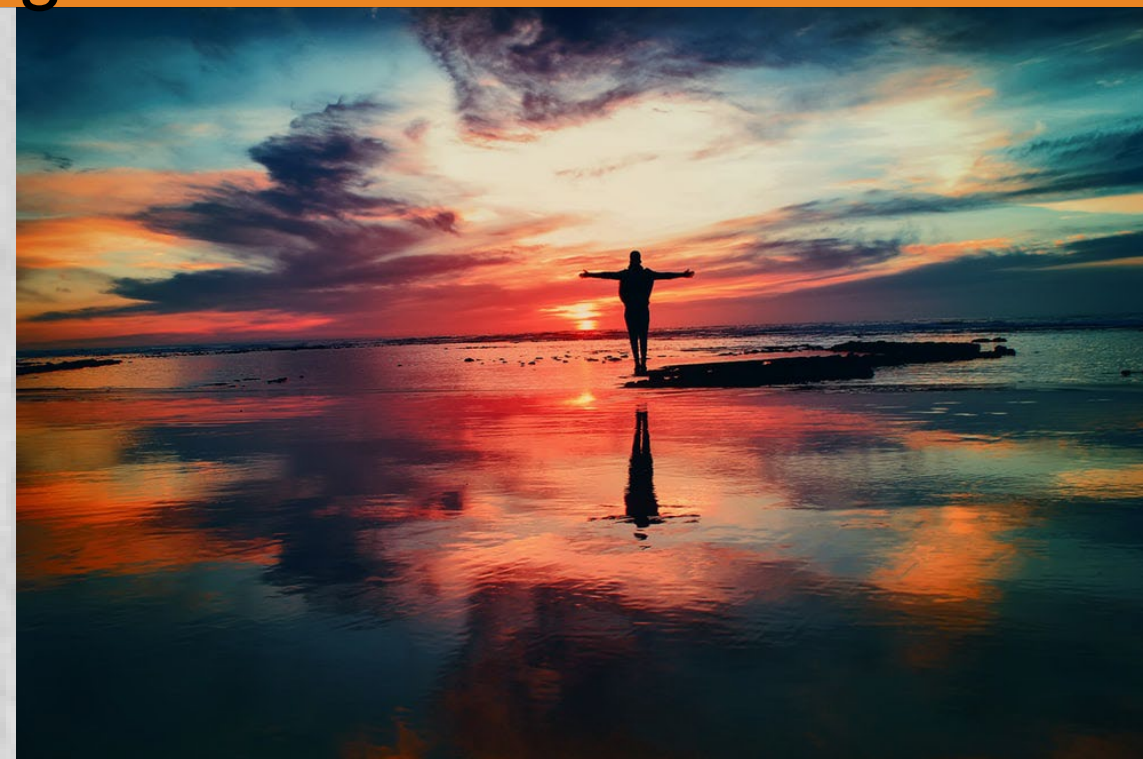
Any individual or family who:

1. Is fleeing, or is attempting to flee, domestic violence;
2. Has no other residence; and
3. Lacks the resources or support networks to obtain other permanent housing

Serving Survivors of DV

To help a DV survivor:

- build trust and show empathy
- believe them
- tell them-- abuse is not their fault
- provide private space to make calls
- connect them with a DV center



The best thing you can do to help a survivor is connect them to a DV Center! Reach out to your local DV center for more resources and training.

Collaborative Applicant & HMIS Updates

ESG by the numbers |

- Served approx. 270 households in spring 2022 with 11 case managers
- Between exiting clients due to ineligibility and MH absorbing 49 cases, currently serve 206 individuals and families. 3 full time case managers, 3 team leads, and 4 part time case managers(OT).
- **72** stably housed clients will graduate on 9/30/22
- Additional exits will be made based on housing stability

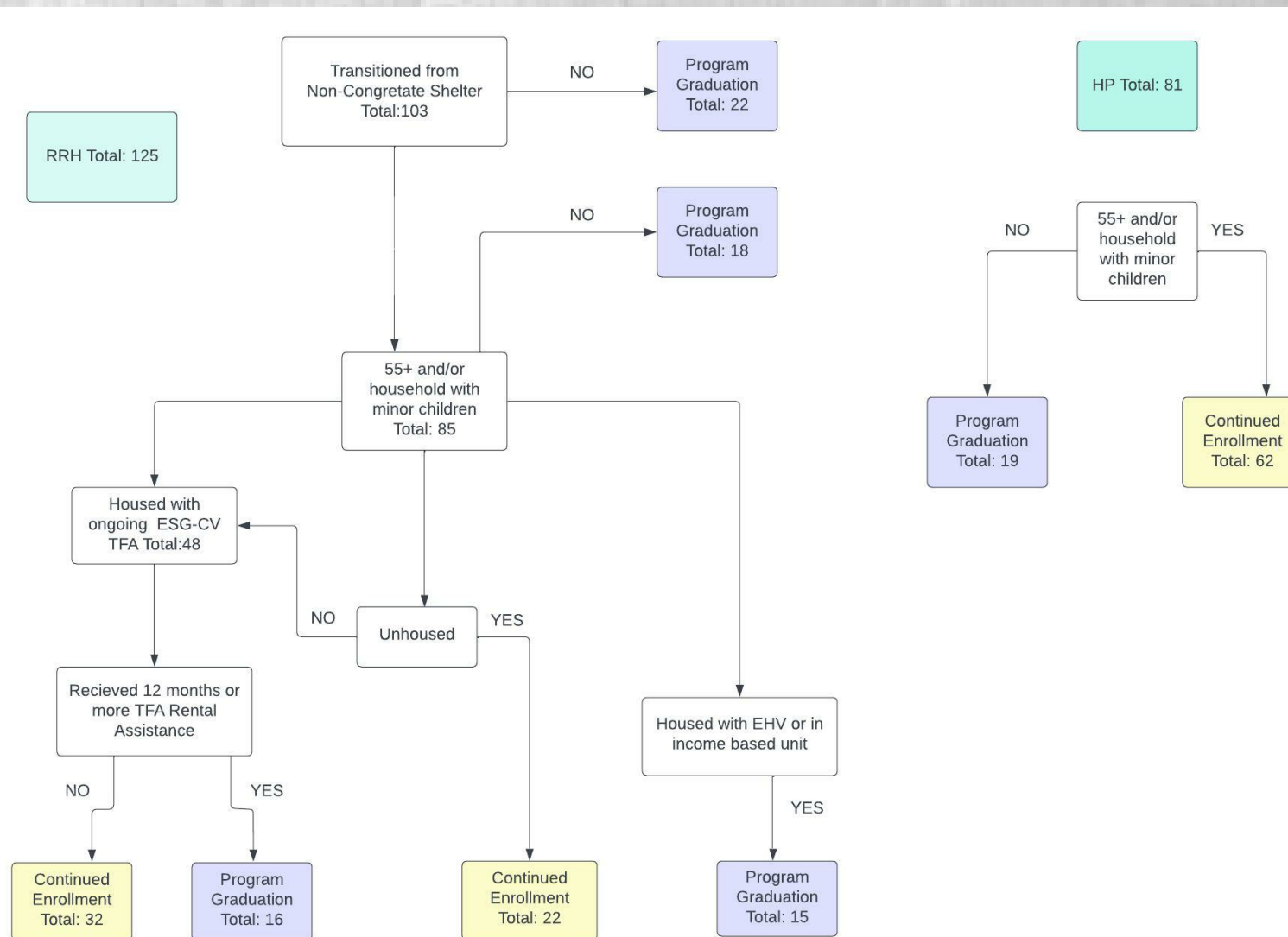
Eligibility Criteria |

- Households who: had a non-congregate shelter enrollment
- Are **not** currently housed utilizing a voucher or in an income-based unit
- AND Meets one of the following conditions:
- Has a household member that is 55 years old and older
- OR
- Has a household member that is under the age of 18.
- Clients who received inconsistent case management

Collaborative Applicant & HMIS Updates

Household Demographics |

- 45% are aged 55+
- 47% have minor children
- 31% are employed
- 31% have zero income
- 32% are unhoused
- 47% are HP



Collaborative Applicant & HMIS Updates

Final Phase of ESG-CV |

- As of 10/1/22, ESG-CV will employ 5 case managers total
- Remaining clients will work toward housing stability



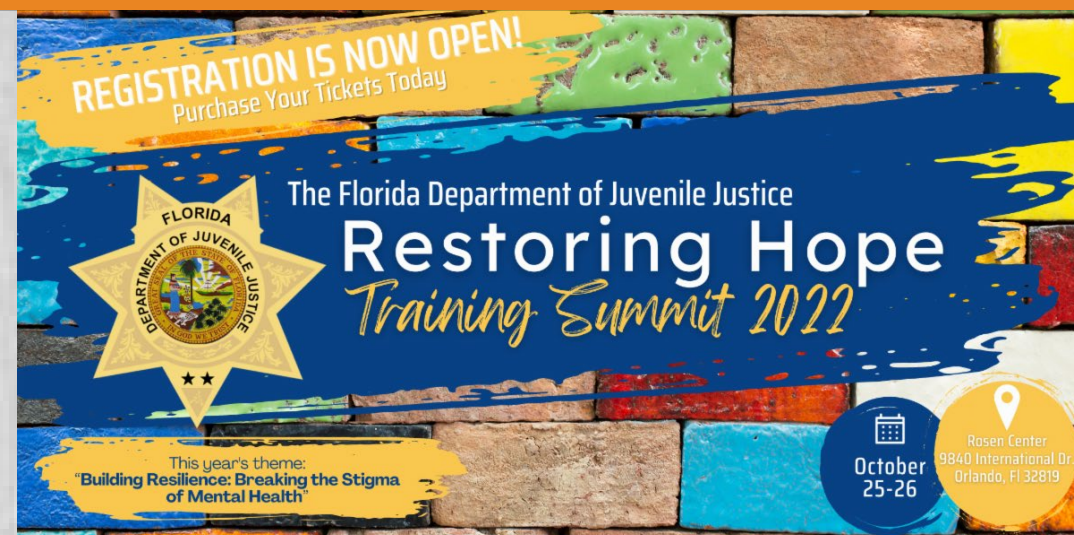
