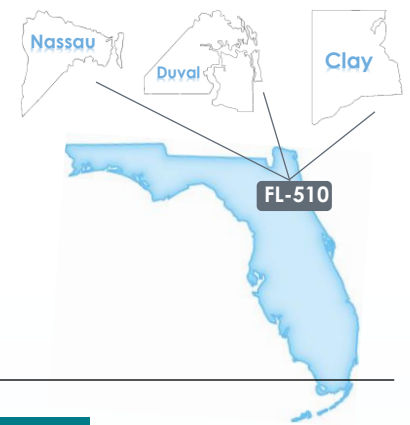




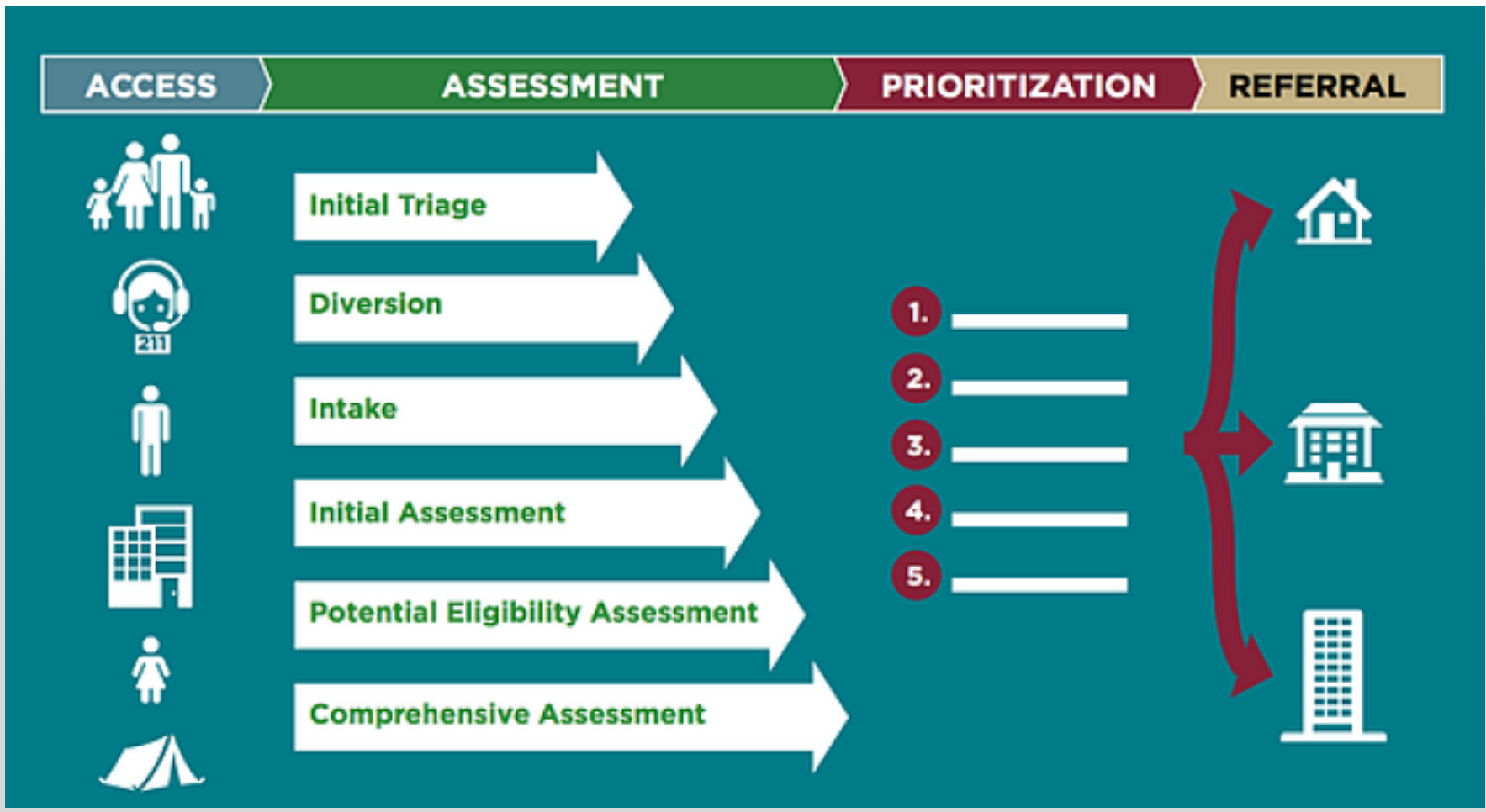
# CES Org Chart

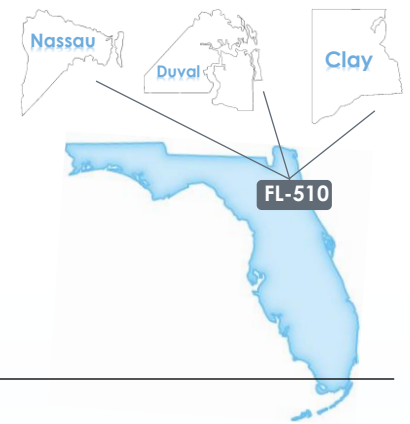
- Coordinated Entry Lead- Changing Homelessness
- New Org structure- dedicated outreach and dedicated referral teams





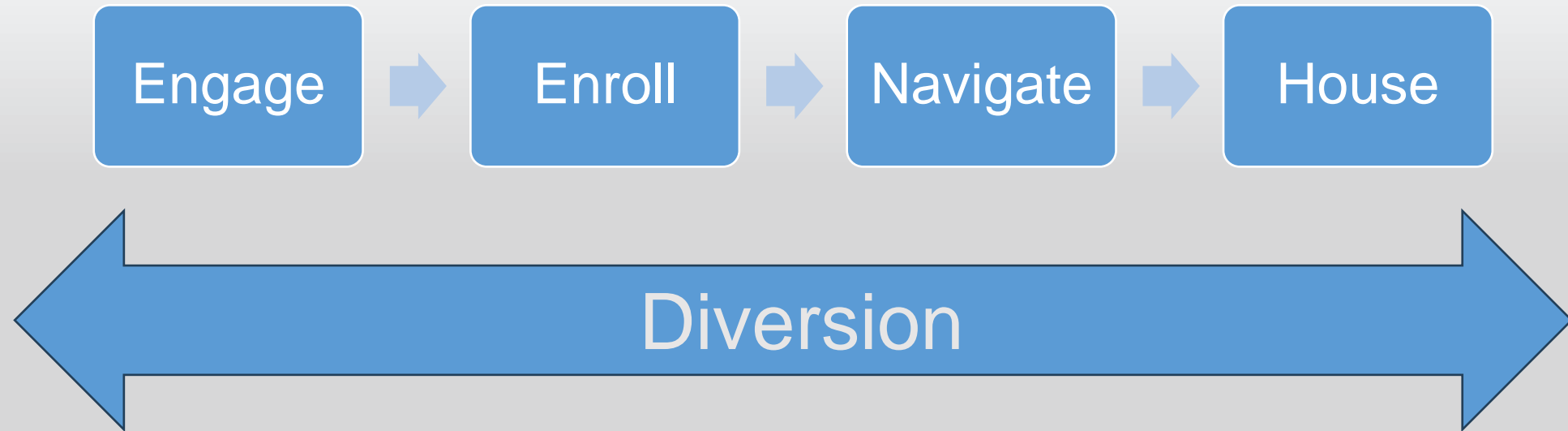
# CES Triage
