- Recipients must continue to use housing quality standards under 24 CFR Part 574, 576 or 578

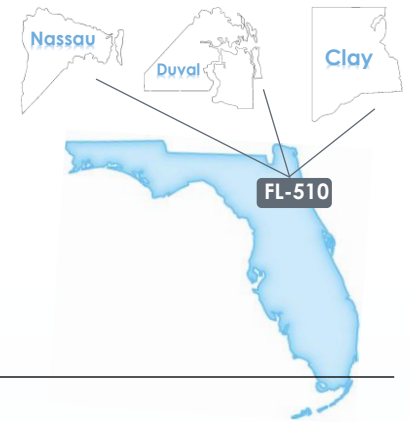

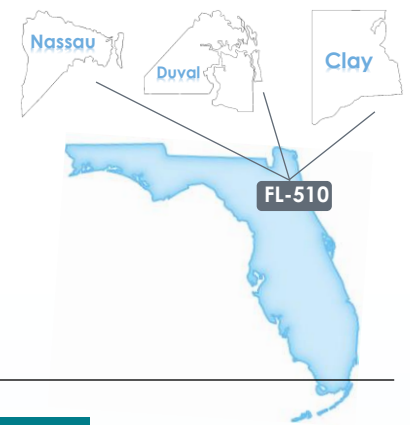




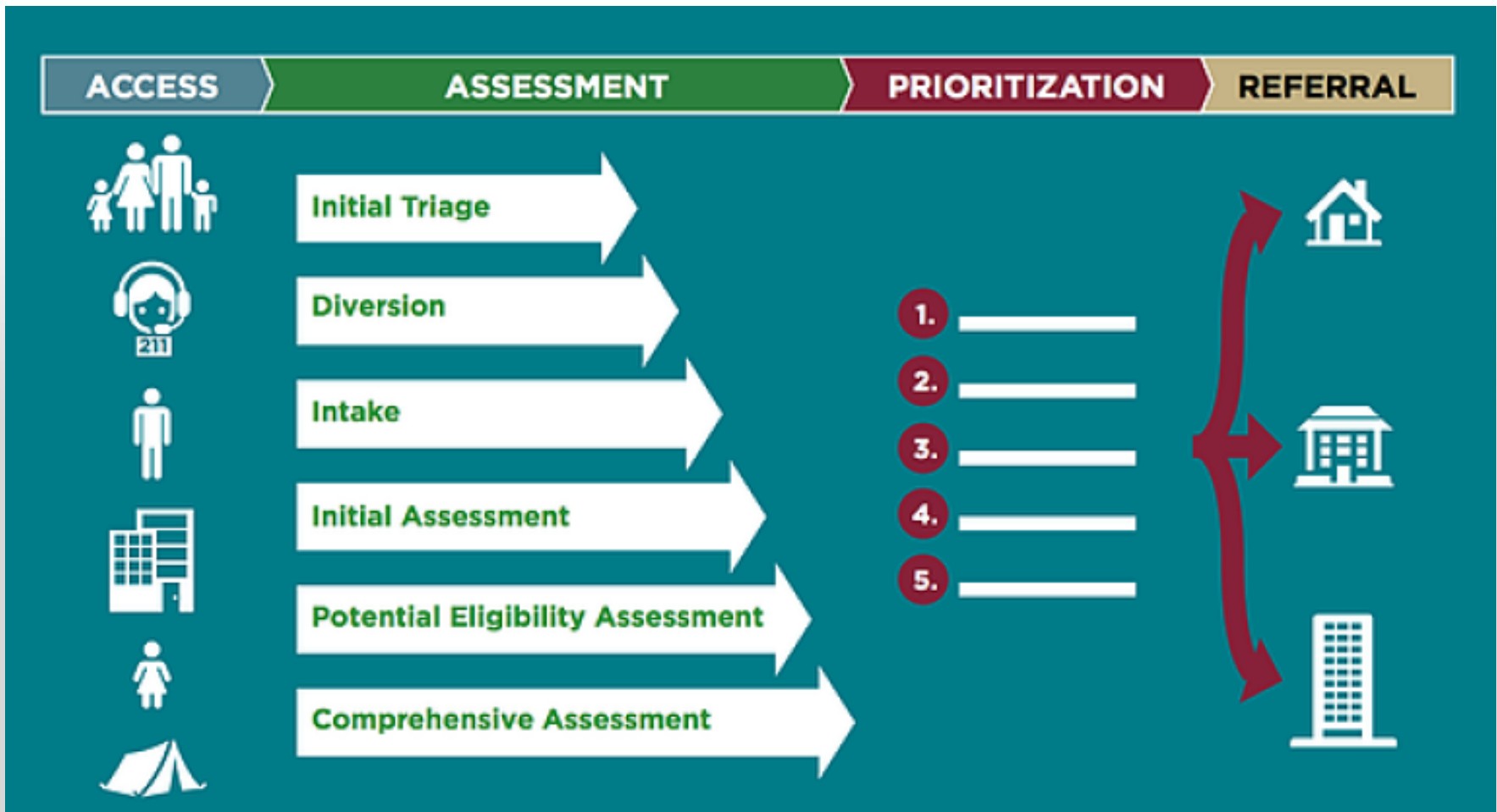
CES Org Chart

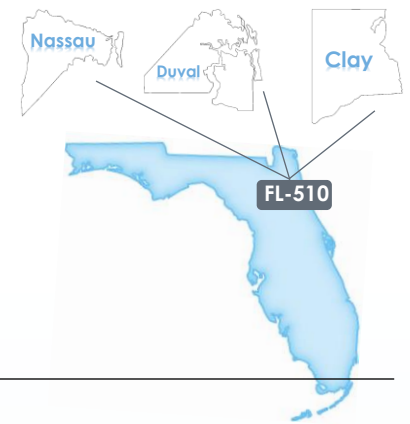
- Coordinated Entry Lead- Changing Homelessness
- New Org structure- dedicated outreach and dedicated referral teams





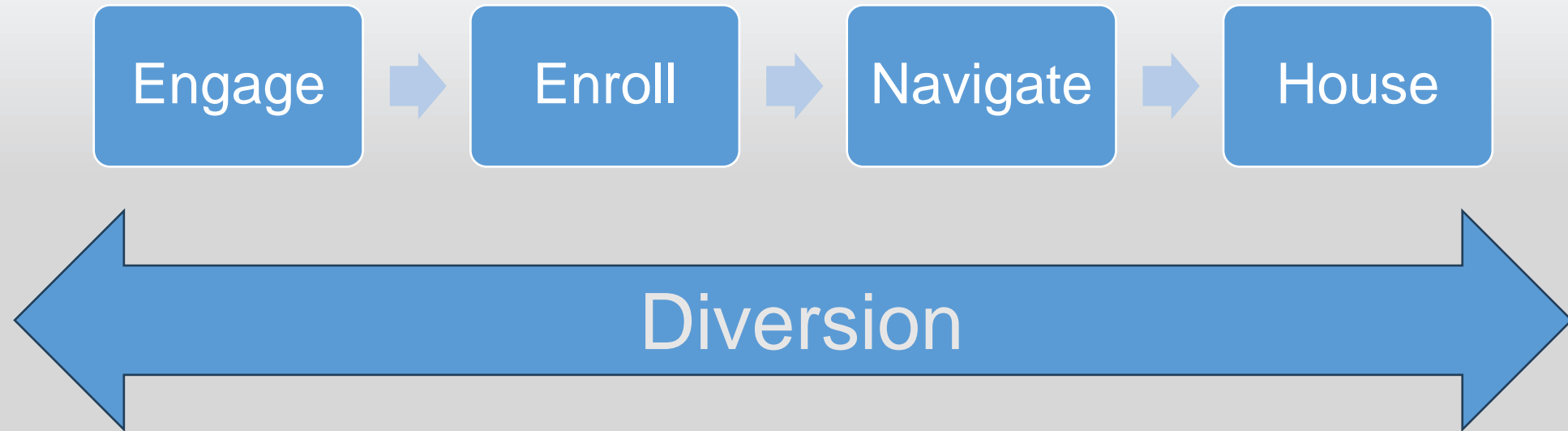
CES Triage

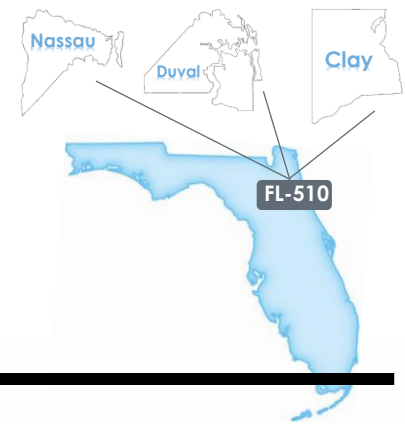
