Bezos Foundation: Day 1 Families Fund

The Day 1 Families Fund issues annual leadership awards to organizations and civic groups doing compassionate, needle-moving work to provide shelter and hunger support to address the immediate needs of young families. The vision statement comes from the inspiring Mary's Place in Seattle: no child sleeps outside.

Since 2018, the Day 1 Families Fund has issued 170 leadership awards totaling \$521.6 million to organizations in 45 states, the District of Columbia, and Puerto Rico.

In the Fall of 2022, Changing Homelessness was awarded \$2.5M

Day 1 Families Fund: Funding Parameters

- 1. Cannot fund prevention
 - a. Diversion + Housing Stability can be funded
- 2. Recipients must be HUD Category 1: Literally Homeless
- 3. Recipients must have children under 18

Day 1 Families: Changing Homelessness Priorities

- Funding should fill gaps, enhance existing funding, allow us to try things that more restrictive funding sources will prohibit
- 2. Group decision making:
 - Consensus on scope of problem + goal
 - Agreement on how to measure progress
 - Ideas to test moving forward


