

### WHAT IS PIT - OUR "POINT IN TIME" COUNT?

#### WHAT:

The PIT Count is a national, HUD mandated, annual census and survey of our neighbors experiencing homelessness. PIT is used to access all kinds of funding for public agencies, as well as *keep* our existing funding. *Everyone* should care about PIT!

### ANGING WHAT IS PIT - OUR "POINT IN TIME" COUNT?

#### **WORKING DEFINITION FROM HUD:**

During our Point In Time Count, we only survey those who fit HUD's definition of "literally homeless" which is as followed:

Category 1	Literally Homeless	<ul> <li>(1) Individual or family who lacks a fixed, regular, and addinighttime residence, meaning: <ul> <li>(i) Has a primary nighttime residence that is a public private place not meant for human habitation;</li> <li>(ii) Is living in a publicly or privately operated shelted designated to provide temporary living arranger (including congregate shelters, transitional house hotels and motels paid for by charitable organization by federal, state and local government programs</li> <li>(iii) Is exiting an institution where (s)he has resided to resided in an emergency shelter not meant for human habitation immediately be entering that institution</li> </ul> </li> </ul>


