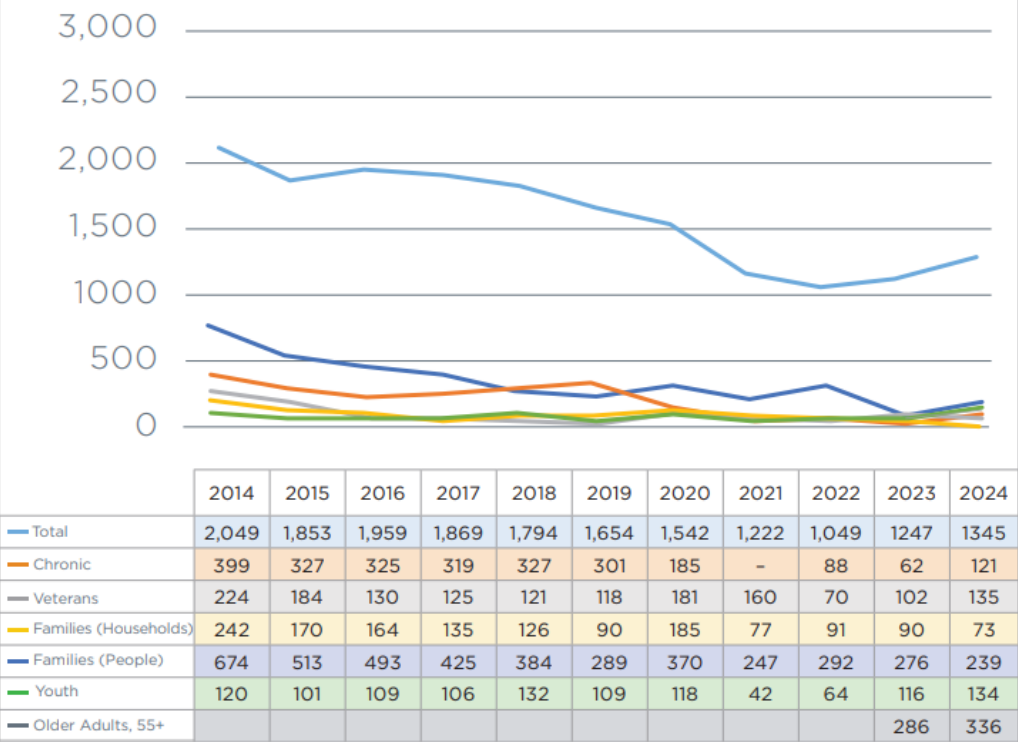

YEAR-OVER-YEAR POINT-IN-TIME TOTALS

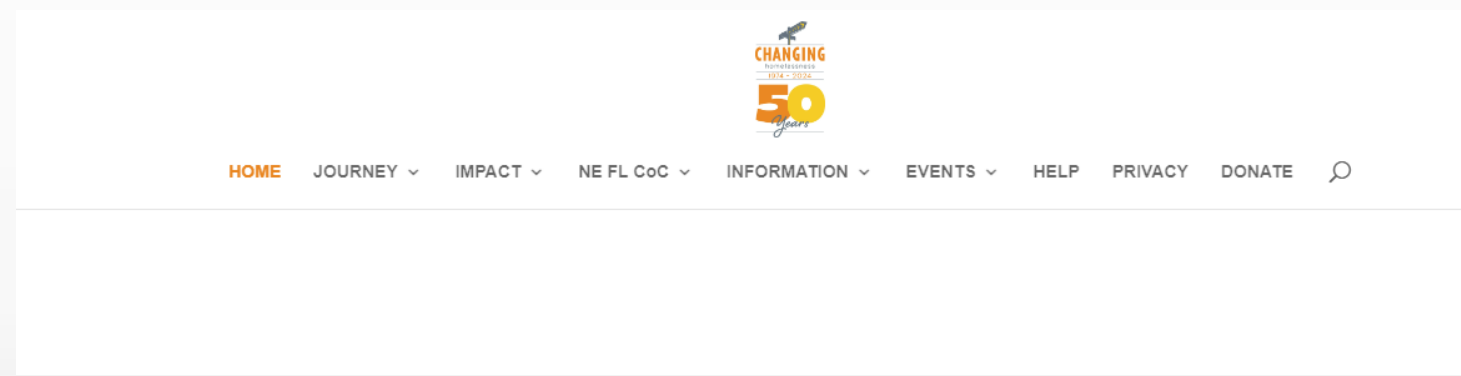


2021 - COVID count, no volunteers and revised count methodology

2023 - First count reporting older adults 55+

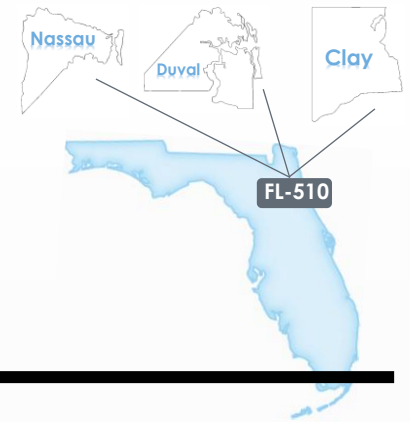
