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1. Improving Outcomes (focusing on reductions in unsheltered homelessness and encampments)
2. Creating Competition to Improve Innovation and Accountability (60% Tier 1/40% Tier 2)
3. Restoring Balance to the Continuum of Care
4. Prioritizing Treatment and Recovery as a Means to Self-Sufficiency
5. Promoting Economic Self-Sufficiency
6. Advancing Public Safety for All
7. Minimizing Trauma for Vulnerable Populations
8. Expanding Access Based on Merit, and Not Ideology



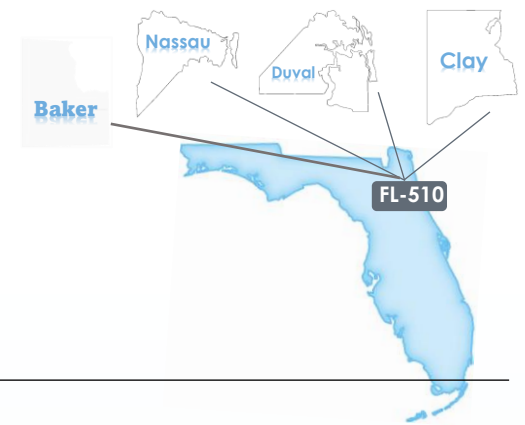

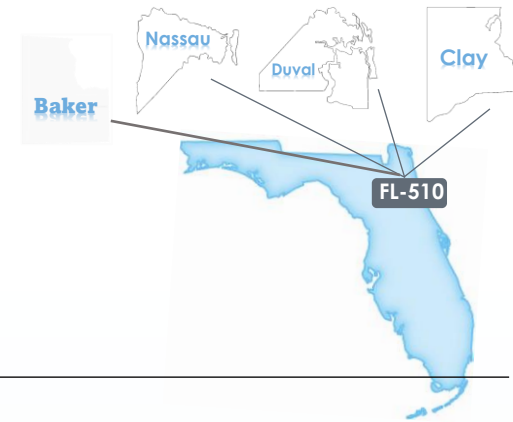

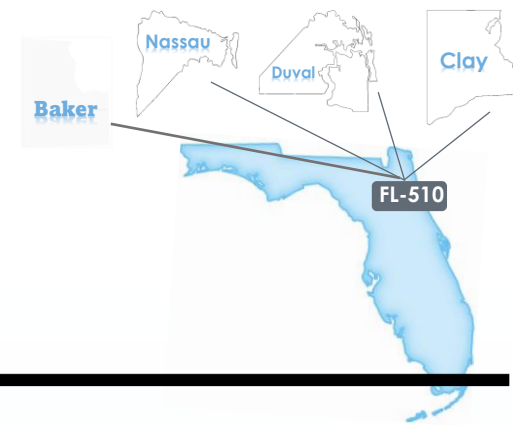

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# LOCAL CoC Priorities

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1. Renewal Coordinated Entry System (CES) and Homeless Management Information (HMIS) System Projects
2. Renewal Permanent Housing (PSH-*over 62 years of age or documented/diagnosed physical/mental disability or RRH-families*)
3. New Transitional Housing (TH) Projects | \$200,000 - \$2 Million
4. New Supportive Services Only | Up to \$500,000 - serve all CoC counties
5. New Supportive Services – Outreach | Up to \$500,000 - serve all CoC counties

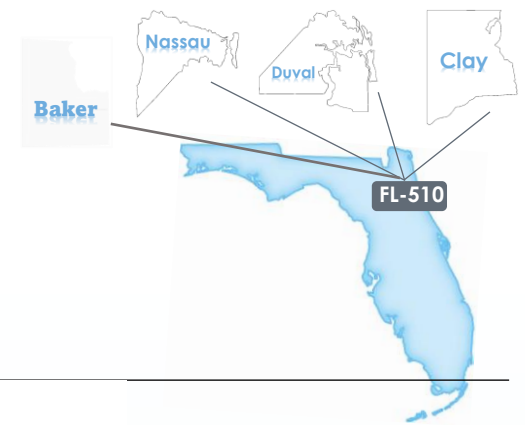
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# CoC Project Application – Required

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**On or before July 10, 2026, complete the On-line Application Form. Detailed Instructions and the Link will be emailed to Bidder’s Conference Attendees.**

1. Create Applicant profile in e-snaps
2. Complete on-line Application Form
3. Upload Required Documents
  - Eligible Applicant Documentation– such as 501(c)3 Documentation
  - Letter of Intent – Project Title, Project and Component Type, Summary and Total Requested
  - Completed e-snaps Applicant Profile
  - Most Recent Agency Audit and 990 2024/2025
  - Match Letter (25%), dated June 1, 2026 to August 26, 2026
  - Project’s Policies and Procedures for which you are submitting a project application, these P&Ps must align with the application and HUD Requirements
  - Budget
  - Data Report (HMIS, Agency database – must be a system used to capture client data)

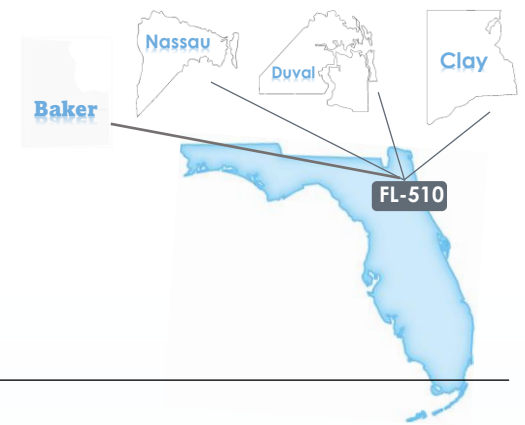
### Threshold Requirements \*

- Member in Good Standing with CoC
- Agency agrees to record project data in HMIS, unless a DV Provider and will use a comparable database providing aggregate data.
- Agency agrees to utilize Coordinated Entry.
- Uploaded Eligible Applicant Documentation (IRS Determination letter - 501(c)3, etc.) For profit organizations are not eligible
- Uploaded Letter of Intent, which includes Project Title, Project Type (Renewal, Transition or New, etc.) and Component Type (TH, SSO, PSH, etc.), Project Summary and Total Requested
- Uploaded Completed E-snaps Applicant Profile
- Uploaded Most Recent Audit and 990 2024 or 2025
- Uploaded Match Letter, dated June 1, 2026 to August 26, 2026
- Uploaded Project Policies and Procedures, must align with current project/HUD requirements
- Uploaded Project Data Report (HMIS or comparable Data System)

# Project Scoresheet Overview

Seven sections with a maximum 174 points

- A. Project Application Threshold – must meet Threshold!
- B. Project Financials- Maximum points: 30
- C. Project Performance/Priority Populations - Maximum points: 50
- D. HMIS Data - Maximum points: 10
- E. Agency Commitment to CoC Priorities- Maximum Points: 10
- F. CoC Participation- Maximum Points: 10
- G. **Project Design- Maximum Points: 64, includes project specific attachment – see NOFO pages 63-68**
